1964 Mouton Cadet

The Mouton Cadet label has existed since the 1930s, when the wine was the second wine of Mouton. In the 1960s, the wine was partially from young vines at Mouton d'Armailhac. The 1964 is still drinking well.

We have some bottles of old red wine from a cellar discovered in the Alliers region, which had been walled up in 1940 to hide the wines from the German troops. The new owners of the property discovered the cellar by accident whilst renovating. The cellar contained a large quantity of wines, mostly without any labels. Amongst the labelled wines, the vintages went from 1904 (Lafite), to 1926 (Vosne and Pommard Rugiens), with a good quantity of wines from the decade 1910 - 1920. We still have a few Burgundy shaped bottles of old reds.
